Annual Conference 2018

Annual Conference 2018 began on June 22 with an opening worship service at Lake Junaluska Assembly. The theme for this year's conference was "Teaching Plants the Seeds for the Future." We celebrated the 50th anniversary of The United Methodist Church as we offered prayers, which were modified from the 1968 General Conference liturgy. The sermon, "Go and Teach," was given by Bishop Sandra Steiner Ball of the West Virginia Conference.

Friday afternoon, I attended the business sessions and the recognition of the retirees, which included our former pastor, Rev. Rob Rollins. Saturday morning began with another business session and a report by Bishop Ken Carter on The Commission on the Way Forward. The Celebration of Life service was especially moving as we honored the lives of the clergy and spouses who had passed away during the past year. We departed from Lake Junaluska with the responsive benediction, "We are people with parts to play in God's story of redemption, forgiveness, and grace!"

First United Methodist Church is hosting Life Line Screening again here on Tuesday, July 24th.

Life Line Screening, a leading provider of community-based preventive health screenings will be in our community on Tuesday, July 24, 2018 at First United Methodist Church of Wadesboro. Ultrasound screenings to Identify risk factors for Cardiovascular disease include; Carotid Artery (plaque buildup-a leading cause of stroke), Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (an enlargement or weak area in the main blood vessel that carries blood from the heart to the rest of the body), Peripheral Arterial Disease (hardening of the arteries in the legs), a Heart Rhythm Screening (an EKG to detect Atrial Fibrillation-irregular heartbeat) and an Osteoporosis Risk Assessment for men and women. Being proactive about your health by knowing your risks helps you and your doctor address problems early.
