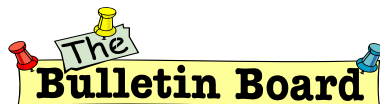
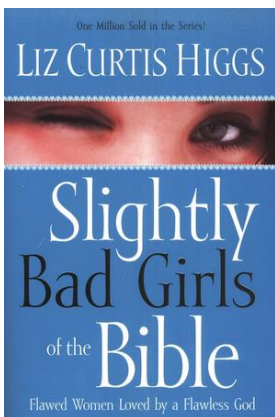
BIBLE STUDY STARTS BACK!!!
